

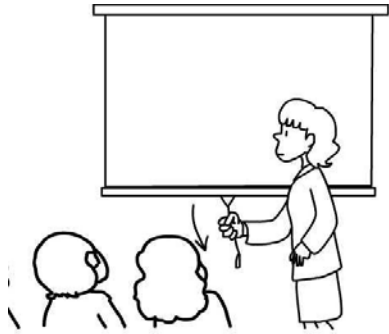

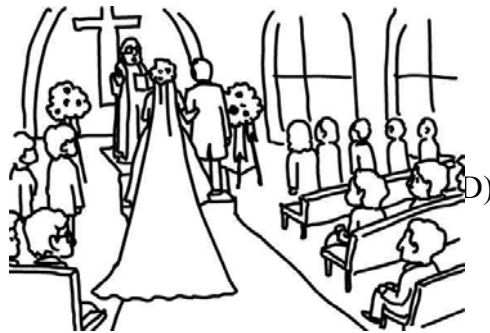

It is difficult to stay safe in the online world because there are always people trying to hack into our computers and steal our personal information. However, there are ways we can protect ourselves, and the best way is to be very careful with what we share on the Internet.

First of all, we have to be careful not to post our personal information such as ID numbers, credit card numbers, or bank account numbers online or give them away to anyone who asks. Instead, they need to be kept private. If these things are stolen, hackers might use them to create false identities or even steal money from our bank accounts. Second, we have to be careful about fake websites that trick people into giving away their passwords or other information. Some hackers would make false websites that look almost the same as the real ones. These are called “phishing websites.” For example, if a web address shows “yah00” instead of “yahoo,” it is very likely to be a fake website, and we should not easily enter our passwords.

Since we all use the Internet very often nowadays, it is important for us to watch out for peeping Toms so that our privacy will not be at risk.
