

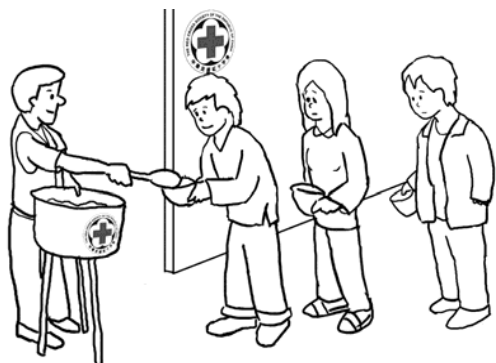

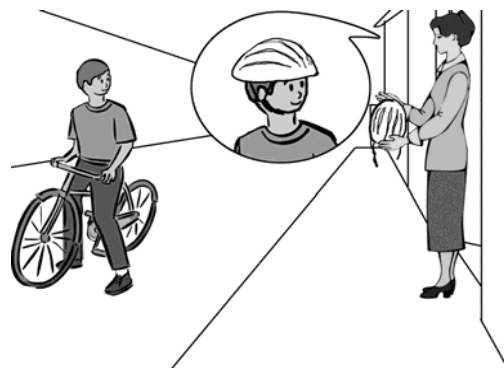

In fact, they saved thousands of lives over the centuries. One St. Bernard named Barry rescued over 40 people during its lifetime.

The St. Bernards' history of saving people's lives dates back to three hundred years ago. At that time, they were simple guard dogs living with the monks at the snowy Great St. Bernard Pass, a dangerous mountain road between Switzerland and Italy.
