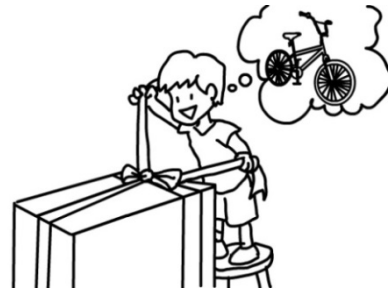

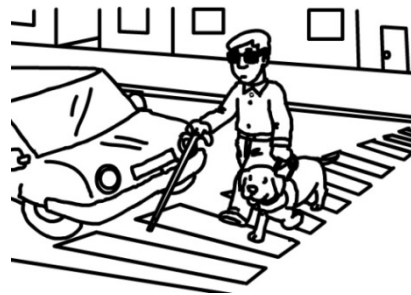

For a long time, people in Taiwan have celebrated Ghost Month, the seventh month of the lunar calendar, when the dead are said to come back from the underworld to feast. The ghosts wander among the living for almost a month, and then they have to go home. The gate to the underworld is closed at the end of the Ghost Month, and the ghosts must return to their resting place in time. In both Touchung in Yilan and Hengchung in Pingtung, people hold a big ceremony on the last day to see off the ghosts. They hold a traditional pole-climbing game that has been around for more than 200 years. It is called Qiang-gu(搶孤).

The event takes place one hour before midnight, when the gate to the spirit world is about to close. Each team sends its members to climb up a 10-meter pole to reach a small platform. And then, one team member has to climb another bamboo tower. The goal is to reach the top of the tower first and grab a flag with a small piece of gold on it, which is believed to protect whoever gets it and bring him good luck for the coming year. Though it sounds easy, the poles are covered with oil and the competition is never easy. Everyone wants to be first. With such a tough competition, Qiang-gu is surely the climax of the Ghost Month and should not be missed.
