In 2003, Google co-founder Larry Page got the idea of posting video street maps online. After making some test videos with his car camera, he set up a project at Stanford University to develop more techniques. By 2005 this project had become Google Maps and Google Earth. Another project, Street View, funded by Luc Vincent, joined them in the same year.

When Google decided to expand the scale of this service in 2006, they first replaced their

traditional video cameras with much smaller devices which could be fit into a small car. Then in 2007, the worldwide street view service was launched when several other projects joined Google, including City8 in China, EveryScape in the U.S. and Location View in Japan.

Such an online service has become practical owing to cheap computer storage. What's more, high-speed networking has made it more accessible.
