What did you eat for breakfast today? It probably wasn't any insect like ants, bees, or beetles. However, around 30 percent of people around the world eat insects in their daily diet. Take Australian aborigines for example. Soft, white worms called grubs are a common food for the people. In Bali, dragonflies are eaten as a favorite dish.
